Hebe Emerald Green is a dwarf growing hebe species from New Zealand. Polished green fine foliage is its main feature as this form of Hebe does not flower.

Silvery Moon

Convolvulus cneorum Silvery Moon

Also known as Silver Bush, *Convolvulus cneorum* is an attractive semi ground cover which provides year-round interest with its silver foliage and masses of large white funnel-shaped flowers from summer to autumn which attract bees and butterflies.



New Blue Moon

Convolvulus mauritanicus Blue Moon

Convolvulus is a genus of about 200 to 250 species of flowering plants in the bindweed family. An attractive ground cover which provides year-round interest and masses of large blue funnel-shaped flowers from summer to autumn.
